Hello, everyone! I hope that you have had a good and safe summer. This has been a good time to stay inside with the hot weather and read.

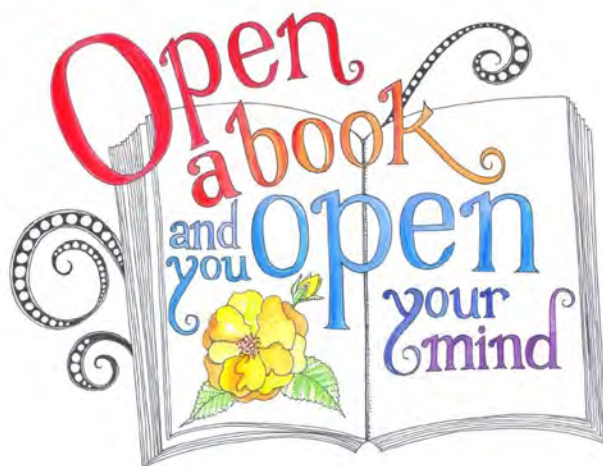
I want to let you know that the new Program Books are in. They can be ordered from the Resource Center. The cost is \$14 each plus shipping.

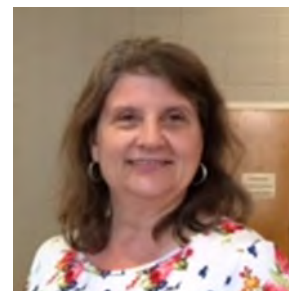

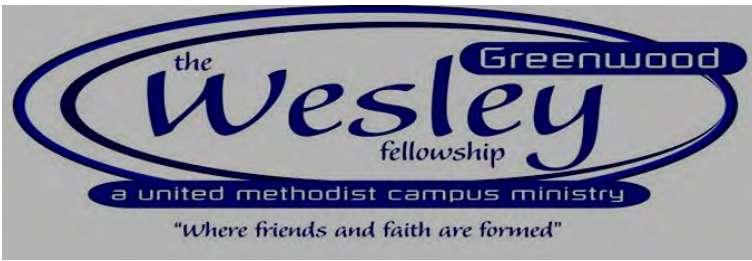

I am the campus minister for the **Greenwood Wesley Fellowship**, the Greenwood District's campus ministry serving the students of **Lander University** and **Piedmont Technical College (PTC)**. We also pray for the students and faculty of Piedmont Tech as well. The GWF board and I are making plans that will meet the needs of our students. This is why I am contacting you.

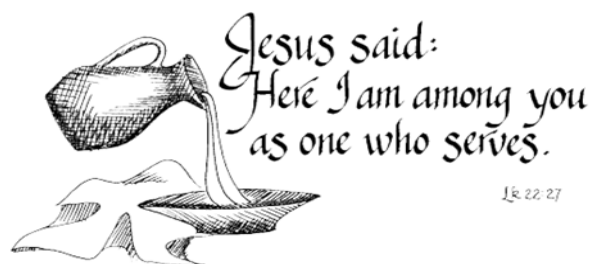
